Understand the different ways to configure glass using Square meter rate or unit rate and various labour to glaze options.
11.00am 11.20am	TEA/COFFEE BREAK Morning Session resumes Ironmongery & Fittings	Understanding how to configure auto select to specify the correct hinge, stays, fasteners or espagnolette fittings. Learn how to set rules for ironmongery and fittings so size of joinery item dictates which option is chosen. Will include examples of how to set up collections in different modules, such as sliding sash collection, door collection or high performance window collection.
